

Little Lambs Children's Sale Consignor Agreement

Fall 2010

1. Consignor agrees to contribute a minimum of 15 appropriate items to participate in the sale.
2. Consignor agrees to pay a \$10 consignor fee when she / he drops items off at the sale. The fee will be halved to \$5 if the consignor uses TagIt or TagIt Lite software and prints his or her tags on cardstock with barcodes.
3. Consignor agrees to put her / his own items on the appropriate racks during the allotted drop off time (this is NOT volunteer time). Items that are "dumped" inside the door will not be included in the sale.
4. Consignor understands that children may not attend the preview sales on Monday.
5. Consignor gives permission for items found with no price to be assigned a fair market price, determined by the one of Little Lambs Children's Sale owners. Consignor agrees that this pricing is final.
6. Consignor understands that it is her / his responsibility to fill out each tag legibly and completely according to the Little Lambs tagging instructions. Consignor agrees that any item found without a consignor number on the tag or an invalid consignor number on the tag will be sold at the owner's discretion and that the consignors cannot expect to receive credit for items without a proper consignor number.
7. Consignor who does not use the appropriate items (3x5" index cards, 1" or larger safety pins), or who otherwise does not follow tagging instructions will be fined \$5. The fine will be deducted from the consignor's check.
8. Consignor agrees that any dishonored check written by the consignor to the Little Lambs Children's Sale will be deducted from his or her proceed check. The deduction will be the face value of the check plus applicable bank fees. We reserve the right to refuse checks from any consignor who's had more than one dishonored check.
9. Each consignor who chooses to volunteer should sign in at the beginning of their shift so Little Lambs has a record of her / his presence. Volunteers who do not show up will be fined \$10 per missed shift and percentage earned will be reduced to what the consignor would earn without that shift's credit. Consignors with a missed shift will not be able to volunteer during the next sale.
10. Consignor agrees that on the last day of the sale, all unsold items will be sold for 50% of the price originally designated by the seller, unless "ND" is visibly and legibly written in the bottom right hand corner of the tag.
11. Consignor understands that only items designated for pick up will be sorted by consignor number at the end of the sale. Items without a "P" after the consignor number in the top left corner of the tag will be donated immediately after the sale ends.
12. **Consignor understands that Little Lambs owners and volunteers do their best to sort remaining items by consignor number after the sale; however, sometimes the number of items to sort or the lack of sufficient volunteer help makes this difficult. We will sort clothing first. Other items will be sorted as time allows. You may be asked to find your own "things" (like shoes, toys, books, movies, etc) if we run out of time.**
13. Consignor agrees that all items not picked up by the end of the designated period become property of the Little Lambs Children's Sale and will be donated immediately to Missouri Mentoring Partnership. Items may be shared with other non-profit organizations in the area and therefore cannot be retrieved after they are donated. **Items that were removed from the sale for poor quality will not be included in the amount on the charitable donation receipt.**
14. Checks will be mailed 3 weeks after the sale. Checks must be processed within 90 days of the date they are written.
15. Consignor agrees to hold harmless and make no claim against the Little Lambs Children's Sale, including the owners, volunteers, or insurers for damage, theft or loss of any item(s) consigned to the Little Lambs Children's Sale. In addition, consignor agrees to waive any and all claims for personal injury resulting from participation in the Little Lambs Children's Sale from whatever cause, either seen or unforeseen, against the Little Lambs Children's Sale, including the owners, volunteers or insurers of the sale. We do not anticipate such problems, but occasionally they do occur.
