What to Bring

Children's fall & winter clothing

Girls: Infant – Juniors

Boys: Infant – Guys 18/20

We will also accept:
maternity clothes (w/ maternity label)
pj's, shoes* and socks*
accessories, purses and backpacks
toys, games, movies and books
sports equipment
baby items and furniture
strollers, high chairs, swings,
& many other items for kids & juniors!

Carseats must be less than 3 years old and have never been recalled or in an accident.

We are accepting gently EWES'd (used) furniture for the family. Visit the "New" tab on the Little Lambs website for details.

*Limit 10 pairs of shoes and 10 packages of socks per consignor. Please limit to items in EXCELLENT condition.

Fall and Winter Items

Pants, sweaters, long-sleeved shirts, Rugby shirts, turtle-necks, thermals, sweats, corduroy, fleece, flannel, velvet or velour, coats, jackets, gloves/mittens, scarves,

Clothing or other items with the following holiday / seasonal themes:
Halloween, Thanksgiving, Christmas, New Years, school, snow, fall, winter, Valentine's Day.

We will NOT accept:

underwear, bags of fast food toys, stuffed animals,
items with holes, stains, or missing buttons, any out of date items,
or spring / summer items like shorts, Capri pants, tanks, flip flops, sandals, etc. For a complete list of seasonal item, go to www.mylittlelambs.com/seasonal

We ALWAYS accept:

Jeans, polo shirts, track / wind suits, khaki or navy pants (school uniform pieces), light weight or terry infant sleepers, short-sleeve t-shirts without seasonal graphics.

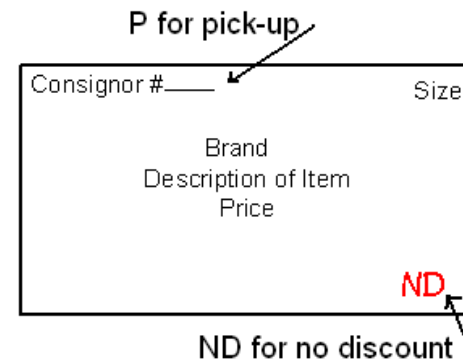
How to price your items

Price items with a minimum value of \$2.00 and in 50 cent increments.

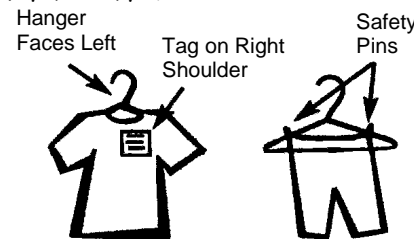
You set the price of your items, but a good rule is about 1/3 of retail price. Most shoppers will pay a little more for name brands or items with retail tags.

REMEMBER...items sell best when they look & smell fresh! It's worth your time to launder & press clothes, clean toys, & write legibly on tags!

Tagging Instructions



1. Using a 3x5 index card, tag items as shown.
2. Write a "P" for "pick up" after your consignor # if you plan to pick up the item if it doesn't sell. Items without a "P" will be donated to Charity immediately after the sale closes.
3. Write "ND" for "no discount" on the bottom right corner if you do NOT want the item to be sold for half price on Saturday.
4. Clothing must be on hangers. The "hook" should make a question mark.
5. Pin the index card on the right shoulder of the garment with a 1" or larger safety pin. Hang pants as shown (or on hanger with pant clips):



There is a \$5 fine for consignors who do not follow our tagging instructions.

All items **MUST** be clean & in great condition. Clothes should be pressed & hung on hangers.

TagIt

Tired of writing tags by hand? Want to keep an inventory list for your own records? TagIt may be for you!

We will half your consignor fee if you use TagIt or TagIt Lite this fall. Restrictions apply...see website for details.

Other Items

- Group items like onesies or socks in a large Ziploc bag.
- Tie shoes together or connect them with a large safety pin. Attach tags to strings or soles.
- Identify toys with multiple parts as part 1 of 3, etc. Price so buyer knows price is for the set (\$4 /set).
- Enclose pieces to large toys in a Ziploc bag. Tape all Ziploc bags closed to keep little hands out!

When items are in a Ziploc bag, tape tag to **OUTSIDE** of bag with a piece of packing tape! Do not attach tag with staples or pins. Do not write information on the bag!

Drop Off

Saturday, October 16 8 am – 6 pm
Sunday, October 17 noon – 6 pm

- Prior to drop off, arrange items by gender & size.
- Bring items to the outside doors of the old Steve & Barry's space at West Park Mall.
- Pay \$20 consignor fee, pick up preview passes, & sign agreement.
- Hang items on appropriate racks! (This is required & isn't counted as volunteering).
